Kumiai successfully defends opposition by ADAMA Agan Ltd to Kumiai's manufacturing process patent related to pyroxasulfone (Australian Patent Application No. 2020300922)

On 4 April 2023, ADAMA Agan Ltd ('ADAMA') filed an opposition proceeding before the Australian Patent Office opposing the grant of Australian Patent Application No. 2020300922, entitled 'Process For Producing Herbicide And Intermediate Thereof' (the '922 Patent'), in the name of Kumiai Chemical Industry Co., Ltd. ('Kumiai'), which claims a process for producing pyroxasulfone.

The hearing of the opposition was conducted on 14 March 2025 at the Australian Patent Office in Canberra, Australia, before a Delegate of the Commissioner of Patents.

On 28 November 2025, the Delegate issued their decision in favour of Kumiai, determining that ADAMA's opposition to the '922 Patent was unsuccessful. The reasons for the decision can be accessed <a href="here">here</a>. Subject to any appeal of the decision, the '922 Patent will proceed to grant.
